



NOTICE OF RACE BLU26 INTERNATIONAL SWISS CHAMPIONSHIP BAYERN

1. Organizing Authority

2. Venue and Date

The Championship will be held from September 15th to September 17th 2017 on the Lake of Tegernsee.

3. Rules

The regatta will be governed by:

- 3.1 WORLD SAILING RRS 2017-2020
- 3.2 WORLD SAILING Addendum Q / Umpired Fleet Racing, with the approval by the Swiss Sailing Federation under WORLD SAILING Regulation 86.3 for the entire duration of this event.
- 3.3 The Swiss Sailing Regulations for Swiss Championships in fleet racing including its implementation regulations will apply.
- 3.4 Blu26 Class Rules, as long as they are not overruled by the Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 3.5 Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions
- 3.6 The Swiss Sailing implementation regulations to WORLD SAILING Regulation 19 (Eligibility Code) and 21 (Anti Doping) will apply.
- 3.7 If there is a conflict between languages regarding NOR or SI, the German text will take precedence. In case of Addendum Q, the English text will prevail.
- 3.8 Advertising: Boats and equipment are provided. Competitor advertising is permitted. The rules apply according to WORLD SAILING rule 80 and regulation 20 and the Swiss Sailing implementation regulations "Advertising".

4. Eligibility

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Blu26 Class. The regatta is open also to sailing teams from other countries.
- 4.2 Eligible teams may enter by online registration (see <http://www.raceoffice.org/B26SM2017>), and upon payment of the required fee. All competitors (*skipper and crew*) must be member of a club affiliated to SWISS SAILING or of another club affiliated to a national authority of WORLD SAILING. (RRS 75)
- 4.3 The skipper must be member of the blu26 International Class Association. It is possible to obtain the membership at the time of registration (EUR 50). Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance.



5. Boats and Sails

The regatta is open to all boats of the Blu26 Class.

6. Entry

- 6.1 The entry must be requested via www.ycbw.de
- 6.2 **Deadline: 31 July 2017.** Entries requested before this deadline that meet the eligibility criteria's are allowed to take part. Late entry is possible until end of August 2017 – addition fee of EUR 50 has to be paid.
- 6.3 **Entry fee: EUR 280 per team** shall be paid by 10 August 2017. IBAN: DE98 7115 2570 0000 2855 36, Yacht-Club Bad Wiessee, BIC: BYLADEM1MIB; In case of late entry, the fee has to be paid within 5 working days.

7. Program

- 7.1 Timetable:

Thursday 14.09.2017:

Registration, team's weight control (see Class Rules C2.2; 350kg), 17.30 to 19.30 at the Yacht-Club. From 19h on: Get-Together / Beer

Friday 15.09.2017:

Registration, team's weight control (see Class Rules C2.2; 350kg: 9.00 to 10.30 at the Yacht-Club.

Skippers' meeting 11.00 at the Yacht-Club/Optihaus.

Earliest possible start: 12.00

Following the races there will be a ‚Brotzeit‘ including a drink at the Bräustüberl Tegernsee.

Saturday 16.09.2017:

Skippers' meeting 9.00 at the Yacht-Club/Optihaus.

Following the races there is a common dinner at Yacht-Club. Friends and family are also welcome.

Sunday 17.09.2017:

Skipper's meeting 9.00 at the Yacht-Club/Optihaus.

Latest possible start on Sunday: 15.00. The award ceremony will follow and afterwards the haul-out will take place.

8. Scoring

To constitute the Championship at least 4 valid races must be sailed during the scheduled time. Low Point System is applied. The worst score will be excluded.

9. Courses

The race courses will be of type „Windward-Leeward course“.

10. Measurement

The measurement controls take place at the harbour of the Yacht-Club Bad Wiessee. No first measurements will be carried out. Boats from Tegernsee should do the measurement controls on Thursday. If there are questions about measurements please contact race@blu26.org.

11. Berthing and Car Parking Spots

- 11.1 Car Parking: during the event parking for free is organised at the Yacht-Club Bad Wiessee.
- 11.2 The provided boats shall be kept in their assigned places in front of the Yacht-Club and at the Sailingcenter.



12. Support Boats

Support boats are not allowed on the lake of Tegernsee.

13. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available from 17.30h on 14.9.2017 at the Yacht-Club Bad Wiessee.

14. Disclaimer of Liability and Insurance

- 14.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 14.2 Wearing an appropriate life jacket from departure and until reaching back the port is mandatory.

15. Radio communication

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones, etc.

16. Prizes

Prizes will be given as follows:

- Swiss Sailing Championship Medals (first 3 teams)
- Further prizes, based on ranking and as communicated at the first skippers' meeting.

17. Where to stay

A number of rooms are available at Hotel Terrassenhof (www.terrassenhof.de) at a special rate. Please mention the Code ,blu26 Tegernsee/sailingcenter'. Capacity is limited – please book early.
